



1. Go to **Chrome.com**




2. Click on **Download Chrome.**




STEPS TO DOWNLOAD GOOGLE CHROME IN IPHONE/IPAD

Are you using Safari or Firefox? Please perform the below steps to download **Google Chrome**.


1. Go to **Chrome.com**




1. Click on the **Windows** icon  from the bottom left of your screen and then click on the **Settings** icon.




2. On the **Windows Settings** screen, click on the **Apps** button.




3. On the **Settings** screen, click on the **Default apps** option from the left pane.



4. Click in the **Web browser** section.




5. On the **Choose an app** popup, select **Google Chrome** option.




STEPS TO SET GOOGLE CHROME AS YOUR DEFAULT BROWSER IN YOUR DESKTOP (MAC OS)

If you are using **Safari**, you can perform the below steps to set **Google Chrome** as your **default** browser.


1. Click on the **System Preferences** icon as shown below.

STEPS TO SET GOOGLE CHROME AS YOUR DEFAULT BROWSER IN YOUR MOBILE (IPHONE/IPAD)




1. Go to **Settings** > Select **Chrome**.

Please ensure that the third-party cookies are not blocked in your browser.




ALLOW CROSS-WEBSITE TRACKING IN GOOGLE CHROME (INCOGNITO MODE)
